



## Mission El Camino Soccer Club Alternate Jersey/Uniform Policy



Through our uniform and logo; our players depict the distinguished soccer heritage that has become the Mission El Camino Soccer Club.

Whenever possible the standard uniform of the Mission El Camino Soccer Club should be worn by all teams affiliated with the Mission El Camino Soccer Club.

The MEC Board of Directors acknowledges that there are occasion in which a uniform that deviates from the standard (“Alternate”) may be needed. Each team is empowered to provide (at the expense of the team) an “Alternate” jersey to be used in play with the approval of the MEC Board of Directors.

### **Acceptable Occasions to Use Alternate Jerseys**

1. Any type of Tournament, District Event, Jamboree or Round Robin type of play. (IE: Summer Bash, Halloween Shoot Out, Roseville at the Break, District Cup, Founders Cup etc.)
2. Any occasion in which the team is engaged in multiple games in the same day. (IE: Opening Day)
3. Home Games: When the opposing team is in a color that is similar (in the opinion of the referee).

Alternate jerseys should be of equal quality to that of the standard uniform. The Alternate jersey should be of good taste and keep with the standards set by MECSC, CVYSL and CYSA for youth soccer teams.

Teams should adhere to the “Alternate Jersey Guidelines” when presenting an alternate jersey for approval. Teams wearing un-approved alternate jerseys may be sanctioned by the MEC Board of Directors; sanctions may include up to the removal of player passes.

The MEC Board of Directors requests that alternate jerseys be proposed at a board meeting for review prior to the use at any event. The MEC Board of Directors reserves the right to refuse the use of any alternate jersey; in the event an alternate jersey is rejected the reasons will be clearly outlined to the coach and the team will be given the opportunity to revise the alternate jersey.

### Alternate Jersey Guidelines

1. No alternate will be accepted if it depicts and/or replicates colors and/or designs of any other standard club jersey playing within CVYSL.
2. Logo's, Trademarks, Emblems and/or any other insignias expressing, promoting, or otherwise symbolizing alcohol, tobacco, controlled substances (drugs), gang affiliations, weapons of any kind and/or violence are specifically prohibited.
3. USSF and the California State Youth Referee Administrator require youth soccer players to have sleeves on their soccer jerseys, MEC will support this decision.
4. As stated in the MEC Constitution colors to be considered should be Black, Grey, Red or White. Other colors can be approved however they should be of an accent in nature not the primary jersey color.
5. Any combination of Black, Grey, Red or white may be acceptable as an alternate jersey.
6. A consistent representation of the Mission El Camino Soccer Club will be made in one or both of the following manners:
  - a. The club name (Mission El Camino Soccer Club) will appear on the front of the jersey.
  - b. The club logo will appear on the front of the jersey. Centered or offset to the left or right is appropriate. The club logo can be provided to the printer of the jersey at the request of the team.
7. Standard numbers must be placed on the back of the jersey large enough to be visible by referees during a match. Numbers may be Black, White or Red.
8. Player names may be placed on the back of the jersey, but are not required.
9. An alternate jersey should be a soccer style jersey (no other sports jersey will be acceptable).
